Tour.**

2. Election of the Chairman for the Civic Year 2007-08.

Cllr Miss Healy invited nominations: Cllr Clayton nominated Cllr Miss Moylan and Cllr Miss Vincent; Cllr Moylan nominated Cllr Miss Healy. A secret ballot was held and after two votes, Cllr Miss Moylan was duly elected as Chairman of the Youth Parish Council.

3. Election of the Vice-Chairman for the Civic Year 2007-08.

The Chairman invited nominations: Cllr Miss Ross nominated Cllr Miss McDonald; Cllr Miss McDonald nominated Cllr Miss Ross; the Chairman nominated Cllr Miss Healy and Cllr Clayton; Cllr Miss Healy nominated Cllr Miss Vincent. A secret ballot was held and Cllr Miss Healy was duly elected as Vice-Chairman of the Youth Parish Council.

4. Apologies.

The apologies from Cllr A Knibb were accepted for the reason given.

5. Minutes of the previous meeting.

ON THE PROPOSITION of the Cllr Clayton, **SECONDED** by Cllr Miss Healy, **IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** that the Minutes of the Meeting held on Tuesday 1st May, 2007 having been circulated, be signed as a true and correct record of the Meeting.

6. Castle Bromwich Youth and Community Centre.

Members expressed their thanks to Dan Wilson and the Centre for their help with this meeting and the work they did in the community.

7. Questions from Councillors.

Cllr Clayton asked if the tennis court work had been completed. Members confirmed that it had and expressed gratitude from the league for the improvements. They also reported personal success with Castle Bromwich players winning the league.

8. Questionnaire.

9. Clerk's Report.
