Apologies.

The apologies from Cllr Miss S Ross were accepted for the reason given. Cllr T Clayton was absent.

2. Minutes of the previous meeting.

ON THE PROPOSITION of the Cllr Miss Healy, **SECONDED** by the Chairman, **IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** that the Minutes of the Meeting held on Tuesday 3rd July, 2007 having been circulated, be signed as a true and correct record of the Meeting.

3. Questions from Councillors.

Cllr Miss Healy reported another pathway that had overgrown bushes making it hazardous for pedestrians. At the suggestion of the Clerk, Cllr Miss Healy would use the Solihull MBC website to report the problem and ask for the matter to be rectified.

4. Future plans for the Youth Council.

At the suggestion of Cllr E Knibb, members considered a Youth Toolkit CD (promoted in a recent WALC newsletter) which offered guidance for project ideas. **IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** to purchase this at a cost of £9.95 and for the Chairman to evaluate it when received.

5. Questionnaire.

Following consideration of minor amendments, **IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** that questionnaire was now ready for distribution and that Parish Councillors who served as governors at the local schools should ask for its use to be encouraged or even used in part of the citizenship curriculum in lessons. The Clerk undertook to make the amendments and publish it on the Parish Council website. Members agreed it should be distributed locally to young people via themselves, Parish Councillors, local organizations, the playing fields and Arden Hall. Cllr E Knibb commended their work.

6. Remembrance Parade – Sunday 11th November, 2007.

The Clerk reported that there would be major changes to the Remembrance Parade this year due to the closure of the British Legion Social Club (but not the Branch), the loss of the Rector of Castle Bromwich and the police no longer taking responsibility for the safety of the parade. However, as before, the Chairman of the Youth Council would be invited to lay a wreath and members would march in the parade on a much shorter route.

7. Clerk's Report.

A possible co-option might take place at the next meeting and then the Clerk would re-issue a contact list to members. A request for provision of mini-soccer facilities was considered and **IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** to support this.
