1. Apologies.

The apologies from Cllr J Horne-MacDonald and Cllr Mrs. J Smith were noted.

2. Declarations of pecuniary or other interests.

3. Planning Applications.

The Planning Applications received since the last meeting were considered by the Committee and the recommendations thereon are set out in the appendix. Members noted the application for Hurst Lane Post Office development had been withdrawn; that the tree application for Cranmore Road had been clarified so their revised view was that it should be approved subject to the views of the Tree Officer; that the Planning Subcommittee of Solihull MBC had met that evening to consider the Chester Arms planning application for sales/storage operations in the car park.

4. Licensing Applications.

After consideration of known facts, **IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** that strong objections made to the previous application still remained. The Council would therefore object strongly to this second application as the Parish Council was clearly aware of existing problems of anti-social behaviour linked to alcohol consumption on the neighbouring Village Green and was endeavouring to support an Alcohol Restricted Zone being put in place.
